Welcome back



RE-OPENING GUIDELINES

In the interests of our staff and all golfers we re-open the course in a phased manner. This updated version of the Welcome Back guidelines is informed by the Scottish Government's directions on dealing with Covid-19:

GOLF COURSE

Access to the course is now open to our Corporate cardholders and guests, as well as local and Scottish golfers and visitors from further away.

Start times are at 10 minute intervals and the following groupings are permissible (based on the latest advice received):

- Individuals playing golf on their own
- Two, Three and Four-ball games, with players coming from no more than 4 households, and as long as they adhere to the Government's physical distancing rules

To access the course, a player must:

- Not be displaying COVID-19 symptoms
- Not be in self-isolation
- Have not been out of the country in the last 14 days
- Have a pre-booked tee time using email or telephone

DRIVING RANGE

The Driving Range will be in operation from 7.30am until the last tee time.

There will be a one-way system in operation and Range bays are at least 3 m apart. When finished on the Range please ensure you exit by walking on the grass behind the mat to ensure keeping 2 m apart from fellow golfers.

The Pitching Green will also be open.

BOOKING TEE TIMES

The course is available to book in advance — no booking restrictions for cardholders and 4 days ahead for golfers using the IV, KW, PH19-41 postcode option. Other visitors can book anytime, subject to availability and restrictions.

The phone number of 01463 796111 will continue to be used for telephone bookings (and available at the times opposite).

OPENING HOURS

Anyone wishing to play must book a tee time in advance. Golfers are NOT permitted to visit the course on the day of play without a pre-booked tee time. For those using the local postcode option, rounds must also be pre-paid.

ARRIVAL

Golfers should travel to the facilities alone, or with a member of the same household.

Ample car parking spaces are available, please be mindful of where you park to ensure adequate social distancing.

The Clubhouse is open as well as the Starter Hut.

Do not proceed to the Starter Hut until no more than 15 minutes before your tee time.

Social distancing measures are in place at the Starters Hut and practice putting green and we ask you to respect appropriate signage.

Hand sanitisers are positioned at appropriate points for your convenience.

TOILETS

Toilet facilities are available.

CHECK-IN

All players must check in at the Clubhouse no more than 30 minutes ahead of their tee time.

Only one person should check in at a time with the Starter and anyone waiting should observe social distancing and wait at a safe distance.

Electric trolleys and pull trolleys are available and sanitised after each round. Hire clubs are available. Electric trolleys should be pre-ordered and pre-paid. Corporate customers can be invoiced.

Buggies are also available. Contact the bookings team for details.

Practice putting green — only the game next to tee off should be on the putting green at any one time.

NOTE: Golfers are asked to observe social distancing always and resist the temptation to get together in groups regardless of size before or after play.

RE-OPENING GUIDELINES

ON THE COURSE

PLEASE observe physical distancing throughout your round, particularly be mindful when on tees and greens.

Rubbish bins are available on the course and please use them.

Bunker rakes are removed. Please smooth sand with your feet or a club after your shot.

Flagsticks **MUST** remain in the hole and must not be touched. Hole cups have been modified for simple, contact-free ball retrieval.

Once a hole is completed, the group in front must have exited the tee box before players can progress to the next hole. Equipment, food, and drink should not be exchanged between players.

Players must not pick up another player's equipment or golf ball.

Players must refrain from any physical contact throughout the round.

PLEASE NOTE: Players must call or email Castle Stuart Golf Links with any post-round health issues or COVID-19 related queries, at the earliest possible opportunity.

Help us to help others, if at any time you are unwell or are showing symptoms, please do not come to play golf until you have sought doctor's advice.

FOOD

Normal menu is now available throughout the day; last orders for food are at 7.00pm and the clubhouse will be closed at 8pm. Alcohol cannot be served indoors.

Up to six people from two households can be seated together.
